Targeted Outreach

- 2,243 people TOP worked with regarding NDIS eligibility
- 2,475 engagement/capacity activities TOP organised
- 4,500 organisations TOP engaged with
- 14 local level engagement groups TOP hosted
- 241 organisations participating and contributing to regular LLEG meetings held in each region
- 1,284 individuals with disability making referrals directly to ART which resulted in \$56 million in NDIS plans across QLD.
- An additional 959 people were referred to other support systems.
- 21 Local Champions with Disability and lived experience of NDIS across the regions
